## • Chapter 21: Evidence, Procedure and Limitation Periods

This chapter has been revised and updated. It refers to professional conduct rules and new requirements for lawyers to remove themselves from the record. Included are recent cases on summary judgment motions and limitation periods for will contests.

#### • Procedural note:

Amendments to the *Rules of Civil Procedure* were made effective January 1, 2019 by Ontario regulations 536/18 and 537/18. One key change covers lawyers applying to remove themselves from the court record. Amendments to Rule 15.04 prevent disclosure of solicitor-client privileged or prejudicial information to other parties or the public.
