- the duty of loyalty a lawyer owes to his or her former clients;
- is a lawyer in a conflict of interest in a joint retainer situation when advising clients on the joint purchase of real property, where there is a personal relationship with the family of one client;
- is a lawyer in a conflict of interest when representing both estranged spouses who are co-defendants in a civil action, and;
- will a solicitor of record for a plaintiff in a commercial lease dispute be removed when acting for both the plaintiff and principal witness of the defendant (to be cross-examined on an affidavit) who has sued the defendant in another proceeding.
