What's New in this Update:

Of note in this release, in *R. v. Long*, 2018 ONCA 282, a five-judge panel of the Court of Appeal for Ontario upheld the constitutionality of s. 490.013(2.1) of the *Criminal Code*. That sub-section imposes a *S.O.I.R.A.* order for life on an offender convicted of more than one designated offence.

The authors maintain and update the offence grid at the back of the text (and in the Martin's Annual *Criminal Code*) on an ongoing basis.
